Wen-An Zhang received the B.Eng. degree in automation and the Ph.D. degree in Control Theory and Control Engineering from Zhejiang University of Technology, China, in 2004 and 2010, respectively. He has been with Zhejiang University of Technology since 2010 where he is now a professor at Department of Automation. He was a senior research associate at Department of Manufacturing Engineering and Engineering Management, City University of Hong Kong, 2010-2011. He was awarded an Alexander von Humboldt Fellowship in 2011-2012. He is a member of

the Technical Committee on Control Theory, Chinese Association of Automation and a member of the IEEE. He is an Excellent Young Scholar awarded by the NSFC, and a Changjiang Excellent Young Scholar awarded by the Chinese Ministry of Education.

His current research interests include cyber-physical systems security, multi-sensor information fusion and its applications to human-machine cooperation. He has been serving as a subject editor for Optimal Control Applications and Methods and Journal of Control and Decision (in Chinese) from 2016. He has authored/co-authored 2 monographs and more than 50 SCI journal papers, and holds 10 patents of invention.
