Ai-Guo Wu received his Ph.D. degree in Control Science and Engineering in Harbin Institute of Technology, 2008. Currently he is a full professor in the Harbin Institute of Technology, Shenzhen. Dr. Wu was a Research Fellow with the Department of Manufacturing Engineering and Engineering Management, City University of Hong Kong from March 2009 to March 2011. He was a visiting professor with the Department of Electrical, Electronic and Computer Engineering of The University of Western Australia, Australia from July 2013 to July 2014.

His research interests include descriptor systems, conjugate product of polynomials, switched system and robust control. He has authored/coauthored one English monograph and more than 60 SCI journal papers. He received the National Natural Science Award (Second Prize) in 2015 from P. R. China, and the National Excellent Doctoral Dissertation Award in 2011 from the Academic Degrees Committee of the State Council and the Ministry of Education of P. R. China. He was supported by the Program for New Century Excellent Talents in University in 2011, and by the National Natural Science Foundation of China for Excellent Young Scholars in 2018.

Dr. Wu is a Reviewer for American Mathematical Review from 2007. He serves as a Regional Editor of Nonlinear Dynamics and Systems Theory from 2015, and an International Subject Editor of Applied Mathematical Modelling from 2017. He was an Outstanding Reviewer for IEEE Transactions on Automatic Control in 2010.
